GUIDELINES | 2019-2020

HISTORY

The **Geis Family Education Endowment Fund** was established in December 2010 to ensure qualifying students are provided access to quality Catholic education, regardless of their ability to pay. The first Geis Scholars scholarships were awarded in the 2011-2012 academic year. The Erwin & Katherine Geis family has a long history of supporting Catholic ministries, and established this Fund as a lasting legacy to their family's commitment to providing a quality Catholic education to eligible students.

PURPOSE

To provide academic scholarships, with opportunity for annual renewal, to students enrolled in Catholic high schools located in Cuyahoga County, in the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland, who have a demonstrated financial need and record of academic success.

SCHOLARSHIP

Academic scholarships of up to \$5,000 each will be awarded to students meeting the criteria cited below, with an opportunity for annual renewal with evidence of sustained excellence in faith, academics, community service and positive peer relationships. **It is strongly encouraged that Principals/Nominating School Officials recommend all “qualifying” students for the scholarship award in addition to submitting renewal applications.** For the 2019-2020 academic year, there are potentially 7 renewal and 5 new scholarship opportunities.

CRITERIA *(students selected to apply):*

- Applicants must be refugees, immigrants, or children of first generation immigrants.
- Applicants must qualify for the free or reduced school lunch program.
- Are currently enrolled in, or have been accepted by, a Catholic High School located in Cuyahoga County in the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland.*
- Can document a minimum scholastic achievement of 3.0 GPA.
- Are involved in school life and consistently demonstrate positive character traits.
- Are willing to participate in an informal gathering hosted by the Geis family representatives. Geis Scholars would have the opportunity to meet their grantor(s) and express how they have benefited from the grant and from their Catholic education.

**The high school application process begins annually in January with notification in February.*



GEIS SCHOLARS PROGRAM

REQUIREMENTS

- Principal/Nominating School Official provides recommended students with the application materials.
- Letter of Recommendation completed by a non-family member.
- New and renewal students complete the Geis Student Essay section of the application.
- Parents complete the Geis Parent section of the application and send the complete package to their principal by March 1, 2019.
- Principal/Nominating School Official completes the school section of the Geis Scholarship application, review the required documentation submitted by the family to ensure completion, and forward the completed information to the Office of Catechetical Formation and Education by March 15, 2019.

NOTE: If any of these requirements cannot be met due to the student or family's limitations, the school should contact Terri Preskar of the Catholic Community Foundation at 216/696-6525 x5090 or tpreskar@catholiccommunity.org within the timeline appropriated below.

TIMELINE

- **MARCH 1, 2019:** Parents/Guardians must return their completed applications with their letters to their Catholic school principal.
- **MARCH 15, 2019:** Principals will send their selected Geis Scholars nominees to the Office of Catechetical Formation and Education, Attention: Cindy Williams, Grant Coordinator.
- **MARCH 18-22, 2019:** The Office of Catechetical Formation and Education will provide a cursory review for completeness of material and send applications to the Geis Foundation Scholarship Committee to make the final selection of awardees.
- **MARCH 25, 2019:** Office of Catechetical Formation and Education mails all qualifying applications to Geis Companies for their final selection process of the 10 awards.
- **APRIL 15, 2019:** The Geis Foundation Scholarship Committee notifies the Office of Catechetical Formation and Education of the final 2019-2020 twelve awardees.
- **MAY 2019:** The Office of Catechetical Formation and Education will send written notification to each of the recipient families and respective Catholic school Principals.
