#### WHAT ARE WE DOING?

The 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Community Service Art Elective Students are raising money to help update the outdoor space at a nearby senior living facility. The Ohio Catholic Credit Union contacted us and said, "We have a challenge for you!"

Based on the Gospel of the Talents\*, the Ohio Catholic Credit Union has agreed to give us \$500 to use to help raise money and benefit a charity of our choice. Our goal is to use the \$500 from the Credit Union to raise more than \$500 for this charity. How we do it is up to us, and part of the challenge!

#### THE PROJECT

To raise the funds needed, we are selling tiles which will be used to create a garden trellis.

The trellis will be displayed on the grounds at Portage Trail Village.

The tiles will be between a 3.5"-5.5" square, depending on how many we sell.

You can sponsor a tile for \$25. (See form\*\*)


The students will be making the tiles and will help assemble the trellis.

The tiles will create a colorful arch for the residents to walk under and enjoy.

We have created a rendering of the finished project, which may vary slightly depending on the total number of tiles



We also have 13 planters which can be sponsored. Each planter will be assigned to a student in our Elective Class, and they will decorate it and fill it with assorted flowers. The planters will be placed throughout the outdoor space at Portage Trail Village. Like the tiles, the planter will also feature a name or phrase of your choice.

To purchase a planter you can select this option on our form (attached). If all 13 planters sell, we have other wonderful art pieces we would love to create as well, and we will reach out to the sponsoring party if necessary.

#### THE GOAL

Our goal is to sell 400 tiles in order to fund the entire project. (\$10,000). The Funds will be used to build the trellis, create the tiles, purchase specific outdoor furniture and outdoor accessories, and hopefully add a retractable awning for the facility!

#### THE FACILITY

Managed and Owned by National Church Residences, *Portage Trail Village* and is located at 45 Cathedral Ln. #103 Cuyahoga Falls Ohio 44223. *The facility is not affiliated with Ernest Angley's organization*. The facility offers assisted living and independent living apartments for seniors and people with disabilities.

### \*Parable of the Talents

The "Parable of the Talents", in <u>Matthew 25:14–30</u> tells of a master who was leaving his house to travel, and, before leaving, entrusted his property to his servants. According to the abilities of each man, one servant received five talents, the second had received two, and the third received only one. The property entrusted to the three servants was worth 8 talents, where a <u>talent</u> was a significant amount of money. Upon returning home, after a long absence, the master asks his three servants for an account of the talents he entrusted to them. The first and the second servants explain that they each put their talents to work, and have doubled the value of the property with which they were entrusted; each servant was rewarded:

His lord said unto him, Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

#### - Matthew 25:23

The third servant, however, had merely hidden his talent, burying it in the ground, and was punished by his master:

He also who had received the one talent came forward, saying, 'Master, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you did not sow, and gathering where you scattered no seed, so I was afraid, and I went and hid your talent in the ground. Here, you have what is yours.' But his master answered him, 'You wicked and slothful servant! You knew that I reap where I have not sown and gather where I scattered no seed? Then you ought to have invested my money with the bankers, and at my coming I should have received what was my own with interest. So take the talent from him and give it to him who has the ten talents. For to everyone who has will more be given, and he will have an abundance. But from the one who has not, even what he has will be taken away. And cast the worthless servant into the outer darkness. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'— *Matthew 25:24—30*
